<p>Comprehension:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can enjoy and understand a wide range of stories, poems and non-fiction text that I can't yet read myself by hearing them read and talking about them with others. I can enjoy reading key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales because I know them well and can retell them and comment on their special features. I can say what might happen next in a story I can talk about the title and events in books I have read or heard. I can usually spot if a word has been read wrongly by following the sense of the text. <p>Word Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can read aloud books that use letters and letter groups I have been taught. I can read many common exception words. I can read new words correctly by blending the letter and letter group sounds I have been taught. I can say quickly the sound of all the letters and letter groups. 	<p>Spelling:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can spell words containing each of the letter sounds I have been taught. (Spelling) I can name the letters of the alphabet in order I can write the correct spellings in simple sentences I hear my teacher say <p>Handwriting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place <p>Composition:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can join my sentences together to make a story. I can read my sentence and check that it makes sense. <p>Grammar, Vocabulary and Punctuation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use capital letters and full stops. I can use question marks and exclamation marks. 	<p>Number and Place Value:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can count to and past 100, forwards and backwards starting from any number. I can count and read numbers to 100 in numerals. I can count and write numbers to 100 in numerals. I can count in jumps of 2, 5 and 10s. I can identify one more and one less, given a starting number. <p>Addition and Subtraction:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use number bonds up to 20. I can use subtraction facts up to 20. <p>Fractions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can find and name 1/2 (half) of an object, shape or amount. <p>Measurement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can solve problems for length and height by telling which objects are longer or shorter/ taller or shorter. I can solve problems for mass and weights by telling which objects are heavier or lighter.
