

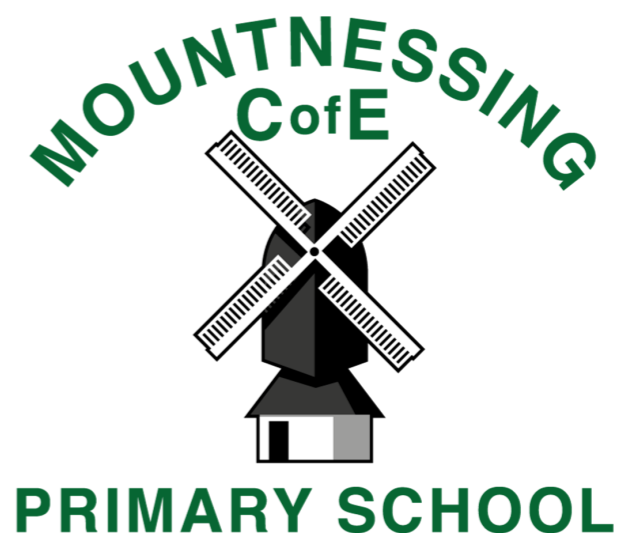
The Child
